A two-sided handout that briefly introduces Generations United FCU and invites members to explore opening an account. Great for including in welcome packets or pew inserts.

Brochure: For informational tables, office visits, or take-home reading

This trifold brochure offers a fuller overview of the credit union, including benefits, products, and how to join. Keep extras on hand for those who want to learn more.

Building upon a long history of commitment to economic justice,1 General Synod XXXI in 2017 adopted a Resolution of Support for Establishing Relationships between United Church of Christ Settings and Community Development Credit Unions. The resolution indicated that economic justice needs have been identified in the communities in which the United Church of Christ serves, "such as the need for financial services to the historically underbanked or unbanked, as well as to victims of extortionate alternative financial-service industry models such as payday lenders." Credit unions were identified as important contributors in the quest for economic justice. Among other things, the resolution called for the national setting of the United Church of Christ ". . . to explore a community development credit union relationship that can serve UCC settings nationwide."


